<p>Watch the news and tell me about one main event. (1 dojo point)</p>	<p>Learn a new skill e.g. tie your shoe laces. (1 dojo point)</p>	<p>Give a peer massage to someone in your family. (1 dojo point)</p>
<p>Visit a river e.g. River Alt in Croxteth Park/ or take a trip on the Mersey Ferry (5 dojo points)</p>	<p>Practice times tables up to 12 x 12. (2 dojo points)</p>	<p>Read a bedtime story (1 dojo points)</p>
<p>Build a habitat for an animal that lives near a river. <i>E.g. build a 3D model, using a computer game to design it, draw it from a bird eye view</i> (5 dojo points)</p>	<p>Spend 20 minutes doing some heart pumping exercises. (1 dojo point)</p>	<p>Spend some time with your family and do some cooking/ baking. Then write a set of instructions for us to follow. (2 dojo points)</p>
