Working at the expected standard:	
Composition	
Organise paragraphs around a theme:	
Compose a sentence orally before writing it	
Sequence sentences to form short narratives	
Handwriting	
Begin to form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place	
2 Form capital letters; form digits 0-9	
Spelling	
Spell words containing each of the 40+ phonemes	
Spell already taught common exception words	
Spell the days of the week	
Use the spelling rule for adding -s or -es as the plural marker for nouns and the third person singular marker for verbs	
Use the prefix un- and use -ing, -ed, -er and -est where no change is needed in the spelling of root words	
Write from memory simple sentences dictated by the teacher that include words taught so far	
Vocabulary, Grammar and Punctuation	
Leave spaces between words	
Join words and sentences using simple connectives sometimes	
Begin to punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark though not consistently	
Begin to use a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week, and the personal pronoun 'I'	
Working at greater depth within the expected standard:	
I can name the letters of the alphabet using letter names to distinguish between alternative spellings of the same sound.	
I can use simple spelling rules.	
I can see which letters belong to which handwriting 'families'.	
I can explain what these words mean: letter, capital letter, word, singular, plural, sentence, punctuation, full stop, question mark, exclamation mark.
