Research the British artist Henry Moore and create a fact file about him. (5 dojo points)	Plan a workout that would help footballers perform better E.g. 3 sets of 10 sprints, 30 jumping jack . (2 dojo points)	Create a timeline of the most significant events in WW1. (2 dojo points)
Create a revision poster which displays all of the prime, square and cube numbers between 1 and 100. (2 dojo points)	Perform an Act of Kindness and record what you did. (1 dojo point)	Create a project based on World War I presented in any way you wish. (5 dojo points)
