<p>Write a story set in an imaginary world using the four following paragraphs: introduction, build up, problem and resolution (4 dojo points)</p>	<p>Do 60 minutes of a new sport/ exercise (2 dojo point)</p>	<p>Practice your 4 and 8 times tables (2 dojo point)</p>
<p>Draw a detailed picture of your imaginary world from the story you created (2 dojo points)</p>	<p>Create an anti-bullying poster (2 dojo points)</p>	<p>Interview someone in your family about their job. Find out the best thing about their job. Tell the class during 'Show and Tell' (1 dojo points)</p>
<p>Build a model settlement of your own imaginary world (5 dojo points)</p>	<p>Make a list of electrical appliances in your house. Categorise them into mains and battery powered. (1 dojo point)</p>	<p>Draw a floor plan of your house. (2 dojo points)</p>
