English

Our English topic will be focused around the book
Where the Wild Things Are' as children will be
exploring fantasy world stories. The children will
begin by exploring the characters in the story
through drama activities alongside their basic

Geography

Maths

We will also be recapping odd and even numbers and will then begin to look at our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will apply our number understanding in a real-life context and develop our problem solving.
