English

Octopus's Garden

We will begin our half term by looking at the lyrics of a famous song by The Beatles. We will use this as the base to conduct some research into creatures that live under the sea. This information will be turned into a non-chronological report about sea creatures. We will then move on to writing riddles about sea creatures, using the information we have already learnt. We will finish the half term by writing our own under the sea riddles.

<u>History</u>

Who were the Beatles?

We will look in detail at the life of the Beatles. We will find out who they were, how they became famous and listen to some of their most popular songs. We will look at significant events in the 1960s and place them on a timeline. We will also be visiting the Beatles Story Museum at the end of the half term.

Maths

The children will look at multiplication and division. Children must know their 2x, 5x and 10x tables. They will use their knowledge of times tables to help them understand the rule of division. They will use a range of practical and written strategies to solve problems.

We will then move onto fractions where we will explore whole, halves and quarters.

We will be looking in detail at who
