Take your pick! These are the homework options for this half term. Children should try and complete at least 2 but they can complete as many as they are able to during the half term. Children can bring their completed pieces into school as and when they are finished.

For each task that you complete you can earn dojo points.



If you achieve the maximum number of dojo points (25 points) – you will be put into a raffle drawer for a special homework prize.

Practice your 4 and 6 times tables. You could use Timestable Rockstars if you wish. (2 dojo points)	Create a project on the Amazon Rainforest. This could be in the form of an information text, PowerPoint, 3D model, artwork etc. (5 dojo points)	Draw a flower and label the parts, for example stem, roots etc. (2 dojo points)
Use this week's spelling to practice your handwriting (1 dojo point)	Make a poster about this week's spellings. (1 dojo point)	Make a collage about the Amazon Rainforest using cut-outs from magazines, newspapers or posters. (1 dojo point)
Make a poster on the effects of deforestation. (5 dojo points)	Practice your 9 times tables. Can you spot a pattern? (1 dojo points)	Show your understanding of the different layers of the rainforest (2 dojo points)
Create a game about one of our topics. (2 dojo points)	Complete an act of kindness (1 dojo point)	Research the life of David Attenborough or Jane Goodall. (2 dojo points)
